GUILD OF SERVICE: : Schooling for Children of Slums Sannidhi Primary School, Najafgarh, Delhi

- Sannidhi Primary School, Najafgarh, is located on the outskirts of the metropolitan capital city of Delhi.
- The School was inaugurated in August 2016 with 40 children. The school now is from Nursery to Grade 5. For the academic year 2022-2023, 147 children were enrolled. 5 parent teacher meetings were held for the year 2022-2023.
- In addition to traditional academic subjects, children are exposed to music & dance, arts & craft, martial arts & sports. They are also taken on field trips.
- The School charges a nominal fee of Rs. 100 per month to give parents a stake in their children's education.
- All children receive free education, free books, stationary, summer & winter uniforms, shoes & socks, a glass of milk on arrival, and a nutritious mid-day meal.
- WRG 2.0 Board member, Tinu Batra and her colleagues David Nachman and Gagan Mundra of NPZ Law Group visited school in November 2022. This is their second visit in the past 5 years. NPZ donated school supplies, medical supplies and cold weather hats, scarves and gloves for the children. The children were happy to meet the visitors! The team was very impressed with how the school operates!



GUILD OF SERVICE: Sannidhi Primary School, Jaipur, Rajasthan

- The success of The Sannidhi Primary School in Najafgarh, encouraged WRG to start a second primary school in Jaipur. The Guild of Service is our local partner in providing a low cost, value based, secular education.
- The Sannidhi Primary School, Jaipur was inaugurated in July 2018 in the Jagatpura slum, near Jaipur airport with 44 children. Now the school is running from Nursery to Grade 3. For the academic year 2022-2023, 65 children were enrolled.
- The school faced many challenges after Covid 19 & teachers are providing revision classes o bring children up to speed.
- All children were receiving not only free education, free books, stationary, summer & winter uniforms, shoes & socks, but also a glass of milk on arrival, and a nutritious mid-day meal.
- The school celebrated its 5th annual day on February 25, 2023. Drs Ritu & Himanshu Sharma, our local supporters attended the program. Himanshu said, "the annual celebrations were held with great enthusiasm and the energy of the children was unbelievable".
- An activity room was added to the school premise in memory of Dr Sharma's father Late Major HK Sharma & their friend's father Late Shanti Chand Hirwat ji. The room has been a great addition for the children.





GUILD OF SERVICE: Sannidhi Vocational Training Institute, Sawai Madhopur, Rajasthan

- Sawai Madhopur is one of the most backward districts in Rajasthan. It's about one and an half hours drive from Jaipur.
- With Guild of Service as the on the ground partner, a three months course in "Beauty and Wellness" was started for young women from disadvantaged backgrounds in 2017.
- Students are trained by instructors from "Kaya Kalp", a well established chain of beauty parlors in Rajasthan. Students receive intensive training with all day classes for four days a week.
- The curriculum incorporates theory and practicals in body, hair and skin care as well as yoga and nutrition, giving participants a holistic view of "beauty".
- Training is free of charge and all the materials are also provided. Scholarships including transportation is given to encourage women from disadvantaged communities to enroll.
- Chandra & Om Bagaria visited the program in February 2023 & were very impressed with how well the center is running. They interacted with trainees (present & some who had completed their course recently). One trainee had started her own parlor & has added a line of products to sell also. Both of them felt that this course has helped these women to be independent & live with dignity.
- At present 13 women are enrolled in Beauty & Wellness Course.



Gunjan Foundation : Swapna Sarthak School (SSS), Gurgaon, Haryana

- The Gunjan Foundation was founded in 2004 with a mission to pursue educational & other welfare measures for uplifting the underprivileged sections of the society.
- The Gunjan foundation's founder, Sushma Singhvi, is a believer in what the first President of India, Dr. Sarvepalli Radhakrishnan had said—"Padhega India, tabhi to badhega India."
- The School was started in 2010 with 60 students.
- In the 2022-2023 academic year all of their students were shifted from SSS to Shishu Kalyan High School and received monetary aid. The Gunjan Foundation provided scholarship to 210 students .
- WRG is providing scholarship to 9 students: Six 7th grade students & three 9th grade students.



EMPOWER THE CHILDREN: Khamagarchi Tribal School & Vocational Training Khamagarchi, Kolkata, West Bengal

- Khamagarchi village is 2 hours north of Kolkata. It is home to a tribal community whose members speak a language known as Santali. Most of the residents are illiterate and live in mud huts, without running water and electricity.
- Empower the Children Foundation (ECH) was founded by Rosalie Giffonello, a retired teacher from Jackson, New Jersey. She found that children from Khamagarchi were not going to the local free government school. WRG started a partnership with the foundation in 2018.
- Kamargachi's non formal education center is mainly for the Santali tribal children. They have their own distinctive culture and language. These children are encouraged to keep their tribal culture along with the Bengali culture of the government school they are attending.
- All the students enjoy the food in school. They get a balanced diet which includes boiled eggs, bread and butter, rice and curry, sweets and fruits. Food is one of the main attraction for students of this under privileged community to come to class. All necessary books, pen, pencils, drawing books are provided free of costs.
- As Khamgarchi children started enrolling in formal schools, remedial classes in science, history, social sciences etc. were also added for mainstream children.
- Last year the Nursery to class IV in Khamargachi center had 62 students
- Three students who had started





PHD FOUNDATION : Community Development Through Skill Training Skill Development Center, Arya Nagar, New Delhi

- The Skill Development Training Center moved from Arya Nagar to Mehrauli (another slum community in south Delhi) in May 2023. Slums are inhabited by diverse, under-privileged, uneducated, and poor working families.
- PHD Family Welfare Association is the local, on the ground partner, for vocational training programs since their mission is consistent with WRG's mission. The center charges no fees for training and materials.
- The Skill Development Training Center was inaugurated in March 2018. It offers two training courses of six-months duration- Computer Education and Tailoring & Embroidery. To earn a certificate, trainees have to pass a theory and a practical test at the completion of training.
- At present 38 youth are enrolled in the Basic Computer course; learning typing, Computer theory and MS Office.
- At present 77 women are enrolled in the Tailoring & Embroidery course.
- These trainings equip them with essential skills, thus enhancing their employment opportunities & promote socioeconomic empowerment & self reliance.



ARYA SAMAJ ARUN VIHAR: Dayanand Silai Kendra , Noida, Uttar Pradesh

- Noida in Uttar Pradesh is east of the capital city of Delhi. The Sewing Center is run by Arya Samaj of Arun Vihar, Noida. Silai Kendra was started in 2007 by retired military personnel.
- The Center teaches tailoring, sewing and embroidery to women from low income families. Most of these women are either illiterate or have a low education level.
- Two batches of classes are held for five days a week for 4 hours each day. **At present 30 trainees are enrolled in the course.** The Center has 10 simple hand and 14 simple foot sewing machines plus 9 machines for more complex jobs like hemming and embroidery etc. From March 2022 onwards the center is affiliated with Singer International.
- Diplomas are awarded to each student after the completion of 6 months theory/ practical training. Each student receives a Sewing Machine at completion of training.
- From August 2022-July 2023, 30 trainees successfully completed the course.



GUILD OF SERVICE

Sannidhi Vocational Training Institute, Vrindavan, Uttar Pradesh

- Sannidhi Vocational Training Institute has been functioning successfully in Vrindavan, also known as the "City of Widows" and "**Temples**". The city is a big tourist attraction for devotees of Lord Krishna.
- Ma Dham is home to widows, even those abandoned by their families, and is run by Guild of Service in Vrindavan. Widows and single young women from Ma Dham and five neighboring villages are encouraged to enroll in the Sannidhi Vocational Training Institute.
- Course offerings are: Temple Economy, Geriatric Nursing, Beauty Culture, Computer Literacy, Garment Production and Pickle Making. These courses are of three to six months duration.
- Since trainees are either widows from Ma Dham or destitute girls & women from neighboring villages, the Institute also provides assistance in finding buyers for their products.

Sandnya Sanwardhan Sanstha (SSS), Nagpur, Maharashtra

- Sanstha's mission is to improve the quality of life of "differently able" children through special education and vocational training with the goal of their eventual rehabilitation.
- A well-rounded education is offered to mentally challenged children and young adults. Support & training is also provided to parents because of the recognition that mentally challenged individuals cannot be rehabilitated without parental support.
- Children and young adults are kept engaged in rehabilitation activities such as making rakhis, Diwali diyas, floral bouquets and the like.
- There are 110 students enrolled in the school since it has reopened from the pandemic.

SISTER NIVEDITA FOUNDATION: Sister Nivedita School on Wheels,

Rajkot, Gujrat

- Sister Nivedita School on wheels (SNSOW) is headquartered in the city of Rajkot, in the western part of Gujrat. SNSOW is working with 91 rural schools, 20,000 students and 660 teachers, in and around Rajkot district.
- Sister Nivedita Foundation started the SNSOW program in 1994. The school has two mobile buses which take teachers and education material to these 91 rural schools.
- WRG has been supporting SNSOW to encourage girls to continue their education beyond middle school by awarding 22 scholarships to girls who have been promoted to 9th grade. This support ensures their continuing education through high school. Some of these girls aspire to be teachers, lawyers, writer, and musician!
- SNSOW aims to empower rural schools & educate marginalized/underprivileged children.
- Below are a few of the students we are sponsoring.




ASIA INITIATIVES: Child Laborer to Entrepreneur

- Udaipur district is in the southwestern part of Rajasthan, just east of the Aravali mountain range.
- WRG in collaboration with Asia Initiatives, and our on-ground partnership with Vidhalaya Udhyam(VU), help improve the chances of financial success of school dropouts and at-risk children in five villages - Chawand, Ambala, Sannada, Sarada and Badgoan in Udiapur district.
- VU works with 13-18 year olds that are either school dropouts who have become child laborers or at-risk students in government schools in remote and rural areas. VU sets up School Businesses which are both educational and profitable. These businesses are called Mind Maker Labs. Students continue their jobs or schooling and then attend Mind Maker sessions. Students receive instruction on the Maker mindset curriculum, design thinking and entrepreneurial mindset.
- Currently there are over 100 students enrolled and over 40 of them are being supported by WRG.
- Rita Chaudhry visited Maker Labs in October 2022 & met with Mr. Tiwari who oversees the program & students. Some of the projects they had put together were Solar lights, portable vacuums, magnetic switches & perfumed soaps. Rita Chaudhary was very impressed with students' knowledge & enthusiasm.
- Such activities encourage students to enhance their life skills & turn inventions into profit making businesses.



ASIA INITIATIVES: DESKIT: A Convertible School Bag/Desk

- Nagada, is a town in the Ujjain district of the Indian state Madhya Pradesh
- In this remote and under-resourced area, acquiring basic infrastructure like desks and chairs remains a major challenge. Students attend classes outdoors and sit on the ground. This not only affects their learning outcome but also creates health issues i.e. chronic back and neck pain at this young age.
- These children belong to low-income and at risk families who depend on schools as an essential community resource and cannot themselves afford to address the gaps in school's capacity.
- WRG is addressing the above issues to improve the learning experience of these underserved students by providing 600 DESKITs to its partner organization Mera Gaon Meri Duniya.
- DESKIT is a unique combination of a lightweight school bag and an ergonomic, foldable, portable and detachable study desk.








Helping Our Homeland USA

The Pro Beauty Academy, Edison, NJ

- Pro Beauty Academy is located in Edison. Edison is home to a diverse immigrant population, dominated by immigrants from the Indian subcontinent.
- Pro Beauty Academy offers comprehensive courses in cosmetology/ hairstyling, barbering, skin care and nail technology. Courses are specifically designed for students to receive a quality education and secure the State License after completing requirements as well as passing written and practical exams. Students also learn the value of professionalism in Cosmetology including high standards of workmanship and personal conduct. Courses run from six months to an year.
- Students graduate with the knowledge and tools and are ready to secure employment in all aspects of this fast growing beauty industry.
- Scholarship recipients are: Christelle Clermont & Aliyah Townsend.

Helping Our Homeland USA

The WRG scholarship program for women pursuing higher education and/or vocational training in New Jersey supports **15 students each year**. Each scholarship is for \$1,000 a year. Scholarship application process consists of a formal application, a 500-word essay, school transcripts, and evidence of financial need. The Scholarship Committee (Kusum Ketkar & Geeta Fozdar) evaluate each application for need and academic performance. All recipients are expected to maintain GPA of 3.0.

New Jersey City University, Jersey City (NJCU)

- New Jersey City University is located in Jersey City, Hudson County. The City is home to a diverse population dominated by Hispanic and African American communities.
- NJCU is an urban, commuter, minority serving public university.
- The University has a special program STEM (Science, Technology, Engineering and Mathematics) for exceptional undergraduates. WRG awards five scholarships of \$1,000 each to STEM students.
- Scholarship recipients: Tekla Tchelidze, Malaak Jaludi, Imane Bigaume, Pal Patel, and Valerie Egharevba.


